

# Making a Donation to The Educators' Trust

## 1. Via 'JustGiving'

This has many advantages to you and to our volunteer trustees:

- You can easily set up a regular direct debit or make a single payment;
- It administers on-going Gift Aid with a direct debit requiring no additional paper forms from you;
- It's secure and easy to track your contribution;
- Simple and efficient JustGiving resources mean all donation records are compiled ready for our accounting purposes.



1. Go to <https://checkout.justgiving.com/3co7grzruq> or use the QR code above;
2. Choose between a one-off donation or a monthly donation;
3. Enter the donation amount and complete the banking details for direct debits or credit/debit card details for single donations;
4. Add Gift Aid to increase your donation by 25%, at no extra cost to you (only reclaimable for tax purposes if you are a UK taxpayer);
5. Depending on any previous visits to JustGiving you may be asked to add a donation to cover their administration for us and other charities. You can enter any figure from zero upward.

## 2. Designate a Bursary

You may wish to designate a more substantial donation (usually £500) with a duration of 3-5 years, as a specific bursary for professional development in a field of your own personal interest.

## 3. Leave a Legacy

Legacies can be used for a named award or bursary for a particular field of education or simply added to the funds to enable the Trust to expand its work in supporting educators.

## 4. Pay our bank directly

***Please do consider again donating via JustGiving before using this option.***

This much reduces our administration costs in accounting and reporting.

*If you make a direct donation by BACS, or Standing Order please e-mail our treasurer to request a Gift Aid claim form ([treasurer@educatorstrust.org.uk](mailto:treasurer@educatorstrust.org.uk)). Unfortunately this has to be completed on paper annually and collated with forms from others. Making direct donations is, of course, welcome — but it does require additional Trust administrative resource.*
