



## Robert J. Jones Award 2024 in Environmental Education

**The Educators' Trust** of the Worshipful Company of Educators annually confers an award for outstanding and inspirational practice in environmental education.

The award for 2024 will be open for nomination of full-time or part-time educators who are teaching, supporting, or facilitating educational activities. This year the award will be for education in pre-school, school pre-6<sup>th</sup> Form, and out of school education up to age 16.

The winner will receive a prize of £500 and be invited to the Trust's Award Dinner in London along with their nominator. They will also be invited to apply for a grant of up to £250 for expenses to assist them with professional development.

The award will be given to an outstanding practitioner in environmental education that relates specifically to living organisms, their relationships to each other and, in particular, their responses to the impact of human activities.
